Article 1, point 4 of Title I in said Regulation:

The grounds, which must be sent to the administrative section of the Doctoral School with the agreement of the Academic Commission, make reference to the need for academic codirection and should be signed by the three directors. Furthermore, at least one of the following requirements must be met: a) the three directors may not belong to the same University, Research Institute or Research Centre; b) the three may not belong to the same field of knowledge"."
